CHRISTIAN EDUCATION BOARD:

Christian Ed is still in the planning stages with Shepherd of the Cross (SOTC) for the confirmation program. Vacation Bible School begins July 10th through July 13th at Grace and ends July 14th at SOTC. A planning meeting for parents and kids who are interested in attending the 2018 Youth Gathering in Texas was held June 25th.

FLAG AND FLAGPOLE ON CHURCH PROPERTY: An anonymous donor has approached the Executive Committee about providing the funds for a US flag and flagpole on church property. This was discussed at the May and June Council meetings and further details will be revealed to the Congregation in August.

FUNDRAISING BOARD:

One-hundred and ninety-four cookbooks (\$1,940) have been sold as of June 25th, leaving 145 books left to sell. If you are still interested, better hurry as they are going fast!

NEW MISSION STATEMENT: The Executive Committee presented three options for a new mission statement. After discussion and deliberation, two were selected to be presented to the Congregation in August.

PICTORIAL DIRECTORY: GLC's portion of the directory was emailed to the company on June 15th for them to insert the individual/group pictures. It is estimated the proof should arrive in about 3 weeks. Once the proof is approved, it will take another 3 weeks for the directory to arrive at Grace; probably sometime in August.

PROPERTY BOARD:

The flat roof project was completed the week of June 11th! Total price was \$41,267.98. The storm on Saturday, June 17th, damaged one of the electric motors that runs the air handler/air conditioner. An insurance claim was filed and the motor has been replaced. The estimated cost of the motor is \$5,500; however, the church has a \$1,000 deductible.

PROJECTOR/VGA UPDATE: Computer Technologies, Inc., has determined that the VGA projector is not worth repairing. A more complete explanation and options to replace will appear in the July newsletter.

RECOGNITION AND APPRECIATION: Pr. Baldwin was presented a card and gift from the Council in celebration of his upcoming 1-year anniversary at Grace.

SOCIAL MINISTRY: The Literacy Program will begin its summer session July 6 and end August 1st.
